## 6. Qualifications

- 1 Those who have completed at least 12 years of secondary school education or an equivalent course.
- 2 Those who are 18 years old or older.  
However, this does not apply to those who have not yet reached the age of 18 but have fulfilled the above paragraph (1) due to the educational circumstances in their home country.
- 3 Those who have been or are likely to be granted entry to Japan through proper procedures.
- 4 Applicants must have the motivation to learn and capability to study the Japanese language, the Japanese society as well as its culture; and can dedicate over 150 hours for a Japanese language course (acquisition of a JLPT N5 level or equivalent) before applying for the Certificate of Eligibility.
- 5 Those who can accommodate the expenses of living in Japan, including school fees, or those who have a financial guarantor who can bear the costs.

## 7. Screening

Applicants will be selected through a screening of documents and an interview with the applicant, including an interview with the financial sponsor.

## 8. Screening Result

We will review the application upon receiving the application documents and screening fee. The applicant will then be notified of the result within 15 days. Among those who will pass the screening, those who receive a Certificate of Eligibility will be issued with an admission permit.

## 9. Application Documents and Procedures

- 1 Application form (designated by the school)
- 2 Photo (6 pcs. 4x3 upper body picture taken within a month)
- 3 Original copy of the Diploma or the Certificate of Graduation from the applicant's previous school and 1 Copy (Translation must be attached)
- 4 Transcript (Original copy) from the person's last school (Translation should be attached)
- 5 Certificate of history of learning Japanese

6 Items related to payment of school fee and living expenses.
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1. If the fees will be paid by the applicant, he/she must provide one or more of the following documents:
  - In the case of scholarship recipients, a certificate of the grant of the scholarship specifying the benefit and the duration of the grant.
  - A bank certificate of deposit balance in the applicant's name.(Note) If necessary, a document to prove the deposit capacity may be requested.
2. If the fees will be paid by the applicant's relatives or others:
  - Letter of financial support that includes a description of why the person will provide financial support and the specific amount of support, etc.
  - Certificate of employment and annual income in the remitter's name
  - Bank Certificate of Deposit Balance in the remitter's name (A copy of the certificate may be required depending on the nationality).
  - Document certifying the person's deposit capacity and a document certifying the relationship with the applicant (Notarization required depending on the nationality).

3. If the fees will be paid by a person residing in Japan:
- Letter of financial support that includes a description of why the person will provide financial support and the specific amount of support, etc.
  - A City Tax Certificate of the cost-bearer issued by the mayor of his or her local government on which the amount of gross income is indicated.

(Note) If necessary, a document to prove the person's ability to pay the cost may be required.

8 Entrance Exam Fee: JPY 20,000

9 Application Period

For the April batch (Japanese Language 2-Year Course), it should be within August-October of the previous year.

For the October batch (Japanese Language 18-month Course), it should be within February-April of the previous year.

\*However, the admission may be closed when the maximum number of people has been reached, so please make an inquiry before applying.

## NOTE

- ① Japanese translation is required if documents to be submitted are issued in a foreign language.
- ② If necessary, submission of "other documents for reference" may be requested.
- ③ The documents to be submitted must be prepared within 6 months (or within 3 months for documents issued in Japan).

## 10. Admission Procedure

The school shall apply for the issuance of a Certificate of Eligibility on behalf of those who have passed the screening.

A certification of admission shall be issued to those who have been granted a Certificate of Eligibility.

To complete the admission, those who are eligible must pay the admission fee, course fee, and other school expenses within 14 days of receiving the notification of the results

## 11. About School Fee Refund

In the event that a Certificate of Eligibility has been issued and you have paid the admission fee, course and other school fees and completed the admission procedures, but the visa is not issued by the Japanese embassy, and thus not enabling you to enroll, you will be refunded in full refund of for school fee including the admission fee.

## About Personal Information
